Monday, May 6 - Sunday, May 19, 2019

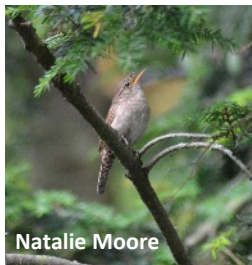
Why Participate?

Completing this challenge allows you to collect important information about popular size and distribution of resident and migratory bird species within Medina County Park District. Your information will be a part of the larger eBird project managed by the Cornell Lab of Ornithology and “the world’s largest biodiversity-related citizen science project.” Plus, there is a raffle with prizes at the end of the challenge! How to Participate

All levels of birders, beginner through expert, are welcome to participate. This challenge requires you to create a completely free eBird account at <https://ebird.org>. Using your eBird account, list all species of birds you are able to identify while in the parks.

- Identify birds from Monday, May 6 - Sunday, May 19, 2019.
- Submit five different checklists on eBird, each from a different park.
- Checklists must be shared on eBird with (no spaces between words) **MedinaCountyParkDistrict**.
- Check off each park as completed on this sheet. Please fill out all information in the spaces provided.
- Challenge forms must be submitted to Wolf Creek Environmental Center or via email to Nichole Schill at nhouze@roadrunner.com by May 31, 2019 for inclusion in a raffle for prizes.
