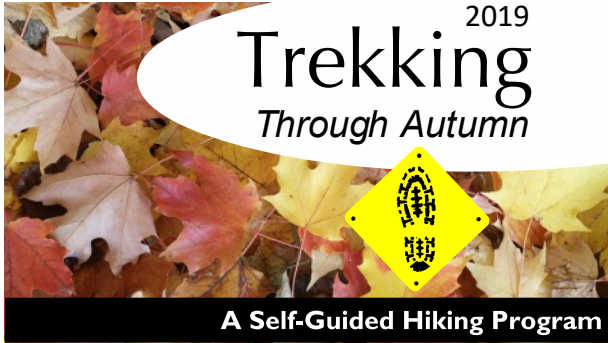




**Medina County

Get out and explore your Medina County parks during the 13th annual Trekking through Autumn program!

Participants who hike eight or more of the designated trails (listed on back) between September 1 and November 30 will receive an award. All parks are open from dawn until dark except Wolf Creek Environmental Center, which is open Tuesday-Saturday from 9 a.m.- 5 p.m. and Sunday from 12-5 p.m.

First-year hikers earn a backpack, and veteran hikers earn a pin. Awards are free for Medina County residents. Out-of-county residents pay \$10 for the backpack and \$3 for a hiking pin.

To claim an award, bring completed forms to Wolf Creek Environmental Center. Deadline for receiving awards is **February 29, 2020.**
