### Building Reopening Dates

Masks are required indoors for individuals who are NOT fully vaccinated.

#### **Park District Headquarters**

Park District Headquarters is now open to the public Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

#### **Oenslager Nature Center (formerly Wolf Creek Environmental Center)**

Oenslager Nature Center is now open to the public Tuesday through Saturday, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Sunday from 12 to 5 p.m.

#### **Susan Hambley Nature Center**

Susan Hambley Nature Center is now open to the public on Saturday and Sunday from 12 to 5 p.m.

### Programs

Naturalist-led programs have a limited capacity and require registration.

### Drinking Fountains

Drinking fountains have been turned on as of July 1.

### Shelter Reservations

Reservations are available for enclosed facilities and open-air shelters. Reservations occurring through July 31, 2021 must contract with and pay for a park-approved cleaning company for janitorial service and disinfection with a peroxide-based solution following the renter's event.

Through 2021, Medina County Park District reserves the right to charge permit holders for additional cleaning and disinfecting services if CDC and state health guidelines change regarding COVID-19.
