Tour Hosts

1. Pioneers in the Park

See demonstrations of pioneer crafts and skills, visit the historical encampment, enjoy live music and entertainment, try your hand at pioneer games and activities, and shop from local crafters.



2. Izaak Walton League

Marvel at this beautiful 75-acre site complete with forests, lakes, and prairies. Take a stroll on the woodland walking trail, try your hand at archery, and learn about wildlife with local conservation agencies.

3. Richardson Farms

Visit this six-generation family farm of fruit and vegetable growers to peruse the animal barns, stop in the retail greenhouses and farm market to shop for local goodies, pick your own apples, and take a hay ride to the pumpkin patch.



4. Litchfield Historical Society

Tour a restored 1846 homestead with memorabilia from early Litchfield residents. Across the street is the circle park and gazebo built by the society to replicate the 1900s wooden gazebo. Pick up a copy of *The Story of Litchfield*, while supplies last! **Saturday, only at 2 p.m.**, the Litchfield Town Band will host a concert in the park gazebo.

5. DeSimone's Country Market

Stop by this country market specializing in local produce and Ohio-made goods. Food samples, farm equipment and educational displays, and a farm animal petting zoo will be offered throughout weekend.

6. York Township Historical Society

The historical society features a one-room schoolhouse, post & beam barn, granary, loom and spinning wheel demos, and antique cars and tractors. Plenty of activities will be on offer for kids, too!



7. Buckeye Library

There will be multiple activities to enjoy throughout the weekend including both kid and adult-friendly crafts and activities, seasonal displays, and family programs. Buckeye Library is home to the Outreach Bookmobile and maintenance/delivery departments for the district.

8. Wolff Dairy Farm

Visit this sixth-generation, family-operated dairy farm that employs conservation practices on its 200 acres. Tour the milking parlor and view barns and equipment ranging from the early 1900s. Family activities will be provided all weekend.

9. Majestic Meadows Alpacas & Boutique




Stop by this family-owned and operated alpaca farm to visit with the herd of 75 champion and ribbon-winning alpacas and other friendly farm animals. Bags of grain are available for a small fee to hand-feed them. Be sure to drop in the Alpaca Boutique to shop for alpaca fiber items.






Points of Interest

A. Bike Signs - DRIVE BY ONLY – three-foot rule. It's the law. Pass cyclists with a minimum of three feet.

B. Sign Our Streams Program - DRIVE BY ONLY - Adopt a stream or river crossing to encourage stewardship of our waterways. Contact Medina County Soil and Water Conservation District for more information.

C. Ravine's Edge Maple Farm - Ravine's Edge is not your ordinary generational farm. Learn the story behind the farm, take a nature walk in the ravine, play in the Indian sugar camp, visit the sugar house, and make some nature crafts!   

D. Weymouth Preservation Society - This local history museum is housed in the historic 1925 Weymouth School and will have kids' vintage games, a hats and bonnets exhibit, root beer floats, a fresh vegetable market, and self-guided tours of the historic cemetery.   

E. John Smart House - A fourteen-room, Queen Anne style building with period furnishings, vintage clothing exhibits, and Medina County history displays. Snacks available.
