Natural Discoveries is an award-based series of free nature programs designed for ages seven (7) to adult. Themed hikes are held on Sundays, and hikes that explore seasonal happenings are offered on Wednesdays. No pre-registration is required.

AWARDS:

- Participants may earn only one (1) award per year (stick or patch).
- Free for all Medina County residents (excluding Hinckley residents)
- Out-of-county and Hinckley residents pay \$15 for hiking stick and \$3 for patch.
- Participants who complete ten (10) hikes in a calendar year earn a wooden hiking staff (one time only).
- Participants who complete five (5) hikes in a calendar year earn a completion patch.

Hikers can claim awards by presenting completed forms to the naturalist leading the program. All awards must be claimed by December 14, 2025.

All Sunday hikes begin at 3 p.m.
