Normal building hours are Tuesday - Saturday 9-5 and Sunday 12-5. Building closed December 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, and January 1<sup>st</sup> for the holidays and January 2<sup>nd</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> for annual maintenance.

**Fish Filcher.** This piscivorous Yule Lad is crazy for fish and with his long fingers, he can pluck them right out of the water!

Needle Puller. Pine needles are Needle Puller's most favorite thing. He sleeps on a bed of them and is always on the lookout for fresh needles to line his nest.





**Boardwalk Burrower.** Watch your toes! This Yule Lad spends most of his time under bridges, peeking out when he hears someone coming to tickle their toes.

**Nest Knocker.** This egg loving Yule Lad is a master tree climber. Even when there are no eggs, he climbs trees, knocking nests to the ground.





Path Poacher. Sometimes called sign stealer, Path Poacher delights in causing confusion by moving around signs and watching people lose their way.


Bench Napper sleeps like a cat but with no home of his own is often found snoozing at parks, bus stops, airports, and other public places.
